Verification Methodology

Manual evaluation of a representative sample of pages reflecting the various methods of publishing information on the website, namely:

- Home page;

- Product listing;
- Product detail page;
- About us;
- Contact;
- Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ).

The following tools were used during the test:

- Google Chrome Desktop;
- Google Chrome Android (Samsung Galaxy S23);
- Firefox Desktop;
- Safari for macOS;
- Safari for iOS (iPhone 12 Pro);
- NVDA Screen Reader in combination with Firefox Desktop;
- JAWS Screen Reader in combination with Google Chrome Desktop;
- TALKBACK Screen Reader in combination with Google Chrome Android.

Where semi-automated evaluation tools were required, the following were used:

- Color-pair Contrast Testing;
- Web Developer Toolbar;
- Visual ARIA;
- W3C HTML Validator;
- Google Lighthouse;
- Mauve++.

Reference Standards

The evaluation was carried out using a sample-based verification methodology.

Reference standards include:

- European Standard EN 301 549 – Accessibility requirements for ICT products and services (UNI EN 301549);
- Web Content Accessibility Guidelines (WCAG) 2.2.
